01/07/12	Rake leaves, cut grass in front and back yard, as needed
01/21/12	Rake leaves, cut grass in front and back yard, as needed
02/04/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard (cut short) Apply lawn weed control
02/18/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard (cut short)
03/03/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard Weed and mulch flower beds in front yard
03/17/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard
03/31/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard Apply lawn fertilizer
04/14/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard
04/28/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard Trim bushes
05/12/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard
05/26/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard
06/09/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard
06/23/12	Cut grass, edge, and weed-eat front and back yard

11/10/12	Weed-eat front and back yard as needed Rake leaves Apply pre-emergent weed control
11/24/12	Weed-eat front and back yard as needed Trim bushes Rake leaves
12/08/12	Weed-eat front and back yard as needed Rake leaves Apply pre-emergent weed control

NOTES:	<p>Every attempt will be made to discern 'good' plants from weeds when weeding. If weeds are allowed to over-run the flower beds, this discernment becomes very difficult. Neither Julia Swanson nor the yard service company shall be held responsible for accidental removal of or damage to 'good' plants in the flower beds.</p> <p>If you prefer the yard crew not weed or mulch your flower beds - that is, if you prefer to do this yourself, drop a note in the mail saying so. Note, however, that if you have submitted such a notice and do not keep the flower beds weeded, the yard crew will weed the flower beds on the days noted above.</p> <p>Ultimately, you are responsible for keeping the grass, plants and trees in your yard healthy and well-maintained. If yard care is needed beyond that noted above, you may do so yourself or additional grassing cutting, weeding, raking, etc. can be secured through a service company, at your cost.</p>
